

COURSE

t ES Dubai we use the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) to determine our student's English level. There are six levels, ranging from A1 (Elementary) to C2 (Proficiency) and we offer an additional Beginner level for students who have never studied English before.

Furthermore, the hours per level have been devised as per the Cambridge English guidelines, in terms of recommended guided learning hours. Although you are recommended to complete the entire level, you may also opt to take individual weeks or shorter programmes as all levels have been divided into 12 rotating learning units which are not a prerequisite to previous or subsequent units.

ELEMENTARY

IELTS 2-3 / TOEIC 151-300 / CAMBRIDGE KET / CEFR A1

You can understand language used in everyday situations if the speaker speaks slowly and clearly. You will learn to use basic phrases, as well as how to introduce yourself and ask and answer questions about personal details. You will also improve by developing your listening and vocabulary.

PRE-INTERMEDIATE

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IELTS 3-4 / TOEIC 301-400 / CEFR A2

You have a general basic ability to communicate in a limited number of familiar situations in which language is used in everyday life. At this level you will learn to understand the main points of simple texts, learn basic grammar and improve your listening and vocabulary use.

hether your aim is to brush up your language skills, improve your English ability to attain a high IELTS score or just study English for the fun of learning, our General English courses will help you achieve your personal objective.

On an ES General English course, you'll develop your language and communication skills, improve your reading, writing, listening and speaking whilst studying a range of topics, depending on your ability. The Academic IELTS examination is recognised as an entrance requirement by British, Australian, Canadian and New Zealand universities as well as for secondary, vocational and training programmes worldwide. This examination allows you to achieve an international qualification in academic English, as well as giving you proof of your English abilities for employers and visa purposes. Our IELTS course prepares students for the academic training modules which assess in four competencies: writing, speaking, listening and reading.

What will I study?

Our IELTS teachers will prepare you for the four components of the IELTS exam – writing, reading, speaking and listening. As part of the course you will have a schedule of different learning activities such as class discussions, report writing, lectures and mock exams to complement your classwork. You will also do regular examination practice under examination conditions to help you acquire good exam techniques. he ES Dubai Academic English course features a cross-curricular approach to teaching students the skills they need to thrive in a real-life academic context while helping them develop academic vocabulary in a range of disciplines and apply critical-thinking skills to a variety of global issues.

Who is this course for?

The Academic English course is designed for students who are preparing for university study in the UAE, UK and other English-speaking countries, and for those who have an IELTS score of between 4.0 and 5.5 on arrival. It's particularly well suited to motivated students who want to make quick progress and intend to improve their IELTS score by up to one full point.

Taught by specialists

We have designed our Academic Preparation Programme specifically for international students, enabling them to gain the confidence and skills they need before progression to further education. Our expert staff has helped hundreds of students who need extra support with their written and spoken English, and our course leaders are IELTS examiners experienced in assessing the student's progress and CEFR level.



COURSE OBJECTIVES

The Academic English course will help students to:

- 1. Adapt to university-style teaching;
- Learn the necessary research skills for university study;
- Improve their overall English language ability and academic presentation techniques;
- 4. Learn effective study techniques;
- 5. Develop learner independence;
- Improve their academic listening skills such as extended listening, active listening and note-taking;
- Improve their academic reading skills suchassummarising and paraphrasing, as well as finding information quickly in texts;
- Improve their academic writing skills such as planning and linking ideas, essay structure and presenting an argument;

STUDENT PLACEMENT & PROCEEDING

PLACEMENT & ASSESSMENT

Prior to joining any of our programmes, students are required to take an online placement test which assesses their writing and reading ability. This is used to determine each individual student's study plan. Upon arrival, a thorough speaking assessment finalizes which class the student is to attend and if there is any requirement for additional lessons.

SPEAKING ASSESSMENT AND MONITORING

Weekly monitoring and assessment of our students' speaking ensures their aptitude in the general Englishspeaking world. Our individual student reports provide an assessment overview of the students' pronunciation, range of grammar and vocabulary, as well as the overall fluency. Students cannot progress to the following level without successfully adhering to these essential criteria.

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT REPORTS (ISRs)

ISRs provide individual feedback to the students halfway through the course and at the end of their level. They indicate whether the student is ready to move up a level or not and also provide information about the student's test results throughout the entire course. The reports also give feedback on their level of speaking, attitude to learning, attendance and class participation. The ISRs allow the instructor to best advise the students' progress.

STUDENT PROGRESS

ES Dubai measures its students' progress in three ways:

BI-WEEKLY PROGRESS TESTS (Min. pass rate: 80%) These progress tests are used to monitor progress and are comprised of language focus, functional language, vocabulary and pronunciation based on bi-weekly units. The students' test results are recorded and appropriate feedback is provided to the student.

MID-TERM TEST (Min. pass rate: 80%)

Mid-term tests are used to determine the students' midway course progress. This is a paper test comprised of grammar focus, functional language, vocabulary, pronunciation, reading and writing based on the first half of the course book's content. Our instructors record results and provide individual student reports before the end of the test week, to be given to the student.

END OF COURSE EXAM (Min. pass rate: 80%)

The End of Course exam is used to determine if the student has mastered the skills and fluency of their current level. It guides the instructor's decision as to whether the student is ready to progress to the next level or not. The paper test is comprised of grammar focus, functional language, vocabulary, pronunciation, reading and writing based on the course book's entire content. An individual student report is completed and feedback is provided to advise the students on their level transfer, if successful.

t ES Dubai, we use the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages(CEFR)todetermineourstudents' English level. There are six levels, ranging from A1 (Elementary) to C2 (Proficiency) and we offer an additional beginner level for students who have never studied English before.

The hours per level have been devised as per the Cambridge English guidelines, in terms of recommended guided learning hours. Each level at ES Dubai consists of 180 lessons of 45 minutes each, plus selfstudy recommended time of an additional 45 hours over the course of 12 weeks if studying semi-intensively, and 6 weeks if following the intensive programme.

The student is able to analyse and interpret subject specific texts and synthesize complex information. The student has acquired greater autonomy and has developed critical thinking, as well as building key academic vocabulary.

UPPER-INTERMEDIATE

(IELTS 5-6 CEFR B2)

The student is able to understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics, including technical discussions in his/her field of specialization. The student can also produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain a viewpoint on a topical issue, giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.

INTERMEDIATE

(IELTS 4-5 CEFR B1)

The student is able to understand the main points of clear, standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school and leisure, as well as produce simple connected text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest. The student can also describe experiences and events and briefly give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans.

PRE-INTERMEDIATE

(IELTS 3-4 CEFR A2)

The student can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance. The student can also describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background, immediate environment and matters in areas of immediate need.

ELEMENTARY

(IELTS 2-3 CEFR A1)

The student understands and uses familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type, as well as being able to introduce himself/herself and others and ask and answer questions about personal details such as where he/she lives, people he/she knows and things he/she has.

Language

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Although Arabic is the official language in the UAE, visitors to Dubai will find that English is the most widely spoken language for business, education, trade and tourism. All road and shop signs, restaurant menus and tourist information leaflets are both in Arabic and English. All universities also teach their programmes in English.

Clothing

Lightweight summer clothing is ideal with a wrap, sweater or jacket for cooler winter nights and air-conditioned premises. Since you are visiting a Muslim country, out of respect for the culture you must note that bikinis, swimsuits and revealing clothing should be confined to the beach or swimming pool.

Currency

There are no currency regulations and foreign currency of almost any denomination is exchanged in the UAE. The dirham is the official currency of the UAE. Dirham notes are in 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500, and 1000 denominations. The dirham is divided into 100 fils. Coins include AED 1, 50, 25, 10 and 5 fils. The prefix is also written as AED. The dirham is index-linked to the US dollar and the usual exchange rate is AED 3.671 = US\$ 1.00.

Climate

Dubai enjoys an arid subtropical climate, with blue skies and sunshine all year round. Temperatures range from lows of 10°C to extreme summer highs of 45°C. The average maximum daily temperature in January is 24°C and the average maximum daily temperature in July is 41°C. Dubai's climate has made the city very well-equipped to cope with the heat, and all indoor spaces, malls, public facilities and transport are air-conditioned.

Safetv

With a very low crime index and high quality of living, Dubai is consistently ranked as one of the safest cities in the world. Dubai residents feel safe walking around or taking transportation alone at night - an important reason why our students love living here! Students should be respectful of the law, as the nation has a zero-tolerance policy towards illegal substance use. Other forms of petty crime are highly punishable.

Transport

Public transport in Dubai is divided into land transport, which comprises buses, metro, taxis and a tram system, as well as marine transport, which includes water taxis, waterbuses and a ferry. Students will find that getting around in Dubai is inexpensive with bus rides costing AED 4 and taxi fares starting at AED 6. The metro is also an excellent way to get around, as it is economical, modern, safe, clean and convenient,

PROCESS

B ooking your course at ES Dubai cannot be easier. We have an interactive online registration system as well as a wide network of international agents, who can assist you along every step of the way. In order to finalise your enrolment, you are required to take an online placement test before arrival.

This test will allow us to place you in the right level and organise your study plan according to your learning objectives. Once your assessment is complete, we will confirm your place and you can proceed with the visa application process.

VISAS

If you are an international, non-resident student, ES Dubai is able to provide you with a sponsored student visa, enabling you to study and reside in the UAE. Sponsorship from ES Dubai is under the DMCC. Visa Length: 3 months, renewable once at the school for the same length, for a total of 180 days.

The ES Dubai sponsored visas are only available for students who enrol on a full-time basis in courses longer than 12 weeks. For students taking programmes of less than 12 weeks, the school will help with the application for short-term visit visas.

Visa Application Process:

The visa application process starts once you have booked and paid for your programme of study. To apply for visa sponsorship, you will need to submit a completed visa application form to our Admissions Officer, along with the required supporting documents.

Requirements to apply:

- 1. Completed application form;
- Passport copy scanned passport should have validity of 6 months when applying for a Student Visa;
- 3. High resolution passport photo scanned;
- 4. Copy of the receipt showing visa fees payment.
